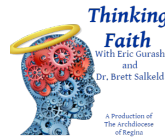
The Archdiocese of Regina Youth Office invites teens and young adults to join them at Leadership Camp this summer!

VATICAN RELEASES ON-LINE QUESTIONNAIRE FOR YOUTH

To involve young people in preparations for the Synod of Bishops on youth in 2018, the Vatican has released an on-line questionnaire to better understand the lives, attitudes and concerns of 16- to 29-year-olds around the world. The questionnaire — available in English, Spanish, French and Italian — can be found on the synod's official site: youth.synod2018.va/content/synod2018/it.html and is open to any young person, regardless of faith or religious belief.

The answers to the questionnaire, along with contributions from bishops, bishops' conferences and other church bodies, "will provide the basis for the drafting of the 'instrumentum laboris,'" or working document for the assembly.
