One of the least known achievements of the ecumenical movement is the consensus on the doctrine of the Eucharist. What is the significance of the agreements reached? What does this mean for interchurch families and ecumenical shared ministries? The Program in Ecumenical Studies and Formation will take place July 10 to 13 this year, at St. Stephen's Anglican Church, Saskatoon. The Visiting Scholars are Rev. Dr. Sandra Beardsall and The Most Rev. Donald Bolen, both highly respected and active in ecumenism, nationally and internationally. All are welcome. The Program in Ecumenical Studies and Formation is a three-year program, dedicated to forming Christians in the theology, history and practice of ecumenism with the churches of Canada and abroad. The intended audience of this program includes ecumenical officers; people in training for ministry; ministry practitioners whose work is located within an ecumenical setting; and lay people who wish to increase their knowledge of the ecumenical movement for greater participation. The program assumes no prior theological training and will be offered each year in Saskatoon. Students who complete all three years will receive a certificate in Ecumenical Studies and Formation from St. Andrew's College and the Prairie Centre for Ecumenism.
