

PALMS FOR ASH WEDNESDAY ASHES

If you have palms in your homes from previous years, please bring them to the church <u>by</u> <u>Sunday, February 11th</u>. There are baskets in the main entrance of the church for the palms.

On Tuesday, February 13th the Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper will be served by the Knights of Columbus from 3pm to 6pm. At 6pm we will celebrate the Rite of Burning the Palms followed by Mass. These ashes will be used Ash Wednesday.



"OREMUS" (Let us Pray)

Beginning February 21st to March 27th, the Bible Study "Oremus" will be held every Wednesday from 7PM to 8:30PM (except Ash

Wednesday) for six weeks.

This is a great opportunity during the season of Lent. There will be a video presentation by Rev. Father Mark Toups, round table discussions, opportunity for questions and answers, and Prayers.
