## A Word About Trauma...

Trauma and associated words are being used more now than ever. Do we know the origins of these words? Are their meanings different now than when they were first used? Each week we will explore a trauma-associated word's origins, meanings and evolution.

### Complex Trauma

The term complex trauma describes both children's exposure to multiple types of pervasive and chronic traumatic events that involve violence, betrayal, exploitation, and loss, such as maltreatment and living in an unsafe family, community, or school settings, as well as the wide-ranging, long-term impact of this exposure. Complex trauma can disrupt the child's secure bonding with caregiver(s), as well as the development and formation of crucial competencies, positive relationships, and a clear sense of self.

Did you know... Pasqua First Nation is a Cree, Saulteaux, and Nakota/Dakota band located northeast of Regina and west of Fort Qu'Appelle with a population of approximately 2,000 members on and off reserve (69% live off the reserve). Chief Joseph Paskwa signed Treaty 4 on September 15, 1874. **Pope Pius XII:** Of the Human Race, *Humani Generis* (1950): the Church does not ban the theory of evolution when it's understood that all things are created by God and the human soul is directly created by God.

**St. Augustine:** Wherever truth is found, it belongs to God.

**FAQ:** Is the Catechism an example of the collegiality of the bishops?

Yes. The collegiality of the Bishops that's presided over by the Bishop of Rome was a truth professed by Vatican II. The Synod of Bishops has been a type of episcopal collegiality since the Council. In an address, on April 30, 1983, Pope John Paul II refers to the Synod as an expression and effective tool of episcopal collegiality ... "The Catechism is a direct result of collegiality through the Synod of Bishops.
